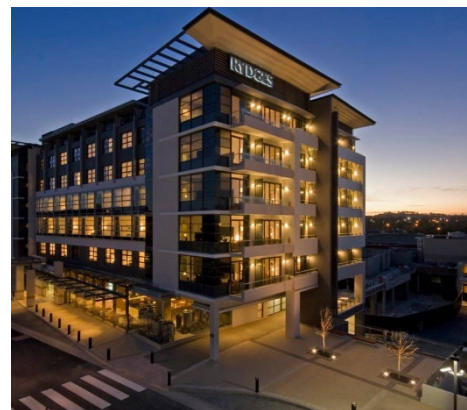

Campbelltown is 53 kilometres south – west of Sydney and gets its name from Elizabeth Campbell, the wife of former Governor of New South Wales Lachlan Macquarie.

If driving from Kingsford Smith Airport (Sydney) you would travel along the M5 motorway for approximately 50 kilometres. Depending on the time of day this can take from 50 minutes to 1 hour plus.

Campbelltown is also serviced by a train line and a train can be caught from the Airport straight to Campbelltown. Follow the signs inside to the Airport terminal to train station, go down to Platform 2 and the train will take you straight to Campbelltown without having to change trains. A shuttle can be arranged from Rydges to pick you up.
